College Success (COLLG 110) is designed to prepare students to navigate the college system and enhance opportunities for success. It's been shown to positively impact Pierce College students. All Pierce College students who begin their studies during or after Summer Quarter 2015 are required to successfully complete COLLG 110 within their first two quarters of attendance.

Approved exceptions to the policy include:

- Students who transfer in 30 or more credits with a cumulative GPA of a 2.0 or higher;
- Students enrolled in a certificate program that is fewer than 25 credits;
- Students who have a degree from a regionally accredited institution;
- Students who are matriculating at another institution and are attending Pierce College for one quarter;
- Students who have successfully completed (2.0, C, P, or higher) an equivalent course at another institution;
- Students enrolled in a statewide Competency Based Education (CBE) program.

If you do not meet one of these exceptions, please attach a detailed statement explaining why you believe you should be exempted from the COLLG 110 requirement.

Exemptions will be granted under limited circumstances and only for compelling reasons that clearly demonstrate an exemption is warranted. Please note that students who receive an exemption to the COLLG 110 requirement must satisfy all certificate or degree requirements.
